





- everything outside the two islands defined on the map is OB, the OB line is either the start of concrete or the outside line of the fence to the softball field
- the mandatory on the second island has to be passed on the right and the mandatory line is perpendicular to the line from tee to basket
- all throws of the tee that either miss the mandatory or land OB proceed to the drop zone on the first island, continue throwing from the drop zone until the disc both passes the mandatory and lands inbounds




- mandatory ahead of tee on the left has to be passed on the right
  mandatory plane is perpendicular to the line between tee and drop zone
  all throws from the tee that miss the mandatory result in the next throw happening from the drop zone • everything beyond the fence on the right of the fairway is OB




- baseball field to the left is OB as marked by the fence
  beach volleyball area behind the basket is OB as marked by the fence
  watch out for players on the fairway of the following hole 4




• everything past the fence separating the road / fairway from the beach volleyball is is OB




- everything outside the marked island is OB
  any player who's first shot from the tee doesn't land safe on the island proceeds to the drop zone
  the player has to keep throwing from the drop zone until a shot lands safe on the island
  once safe on the island normal OB rules apply



the football field is out of bounds as marked
everything beyond the property line as marked by the fence is out of bounds




the football field is out of bounds as marked
everything beyond the fence on the right and behind the basket is OB




- everything beyond the fence separating the football field from the fairway is OB
  the OB line on the right is marked by the fairway facing side of the fence
  the fenced in enclosure on the left is OB


- everything beyond the fence marking the property line on the left is OB
  the concrete path running the whole length of the fairway is played as a hazard, any disc that lands on the concrete path is played from where it lands but the player receives a penalty stroke




- everything beyond the fence separating the football field from the fairway is OB
  the OB line past the fence around the corner in the direction of the basket is marked by the football field markings
  everything beyond the property line on the right as marked by the fence is OB




• everything beyond the fence marking the property line is OB




everything beyond the concrete wall surrounding the oval of the fairway is OB
the OB line is marked by the fairway facing side of the wall




everything beyond the concrete wall separating hole 11 & 12 on the right is OB
 the OB line is marked by the fairway facing side of the wall



• the area directly below the heating pipe behind the basket is designated as a relief area and relief may be taken towards the basket according to OB rules but without a penalty




the path beyond the basket and the main path are OB
the OB line is the line of the path facing side of the curb




- the inner concrete oval is played as a special OB area


- any players who's disc lands in the OB area from the tee proceeds to the drop zone
  the border of the OB area is marked by the inside edge of the concrete wall
  the area directly below the heating pipe behind the basket is designated as a relief area and relief may be taken towards the basket according to OB rules but without a penalty



- the hole is played as an island, the OB is as follows: the path behind the basket and beyond is OB, the line on the left side of the tee of 17 marks the OB on the right, the main path marks the OB on the left, the outside of the concrete wall pointing towards the basket and the adjoining ramp marks the OB towards the tee
- any disc that does not land in bounds from the tee moves to the drop zone which is marked on the concrete wall on the island side, for throws that go OB from the DZ or island normal OB rules apply



- the roofs of all adjoining buildings are considered out of bounds
  players can take relief according to out of bounds rules without a penalty from the walls of the buildings surrounding the fairway
  everything beyond the property line as marked by the fence is out of bounds



• the concrete area to the left of the fairway behind the tree line is OB
